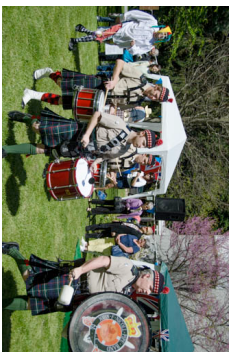

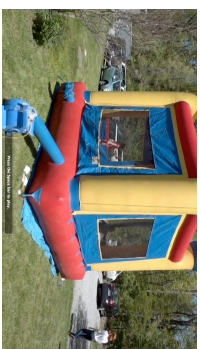
Games of Chance

Our pub serves wine, soft drinks, and beer—choose on tap, or in bottles. Outdoor seating is available under the trees, with a good view of all of the activities in the center of the Village Green.

Pub Grub

Located right next to the Barley Mow, choose authentic pub grub such as ploughman's Lunches, sausage rolls, and Welsh and Cornish pasties; or hot dogs and wraps, for those who prefer American fare.



Flower & Herb Stall

Get a start on your gardening with flowers and herbs ready for planting: impatiens, petunias, marigolds, geraniums, and perennials for decoration, and the usual suspects (parsley, sage, rosemary, and thyme) plus a few others for your kitchen.



Baked Goods

St Stephen's does very well with desserts, as anyone knows who as attended a reception after Evensong, or patronized the Cookie Walk. Cakes are now available in half and quarter portions, plus cookies, brownies, and raspberry crowns, which sold like hotcakes.
