

St. Stephen's Cookie Walk is a tradition that is now almost two decades old. On the first Saturday of December, the Parish Hall is host to the parish's Christmas Bazaar, the Parish Life Committee's primary fundraiser. People from miles around flock to St. Stephen's to purchase homemade jams and jellies, Christmas puddings, table greens, and stocking stuffer gifts. But first and foremost, they come for the cookies: around a thousand pounds of homemade cookes prepared by our parishioners. You can read more of the history of the Cookie Walk in Volume II of this cookbook.

This cookbook contains our parishioners' favorite cookie recipes. It is a reprint, in two volumes, of the very first St.Stephen's cookbook, originally published in 2000. This is the cookbook that started a long series, which now includes the Treasury of Wednesday Evening Soup Recipes (2003), the Treasury of Church Social Hors D'œuvre Recipes (2005), and the Treasury of Church Picnic Salads (2006), the Treasury of Just Desserts (2007, in two volumes), and the Treasury of Summer Suppers (2008).
