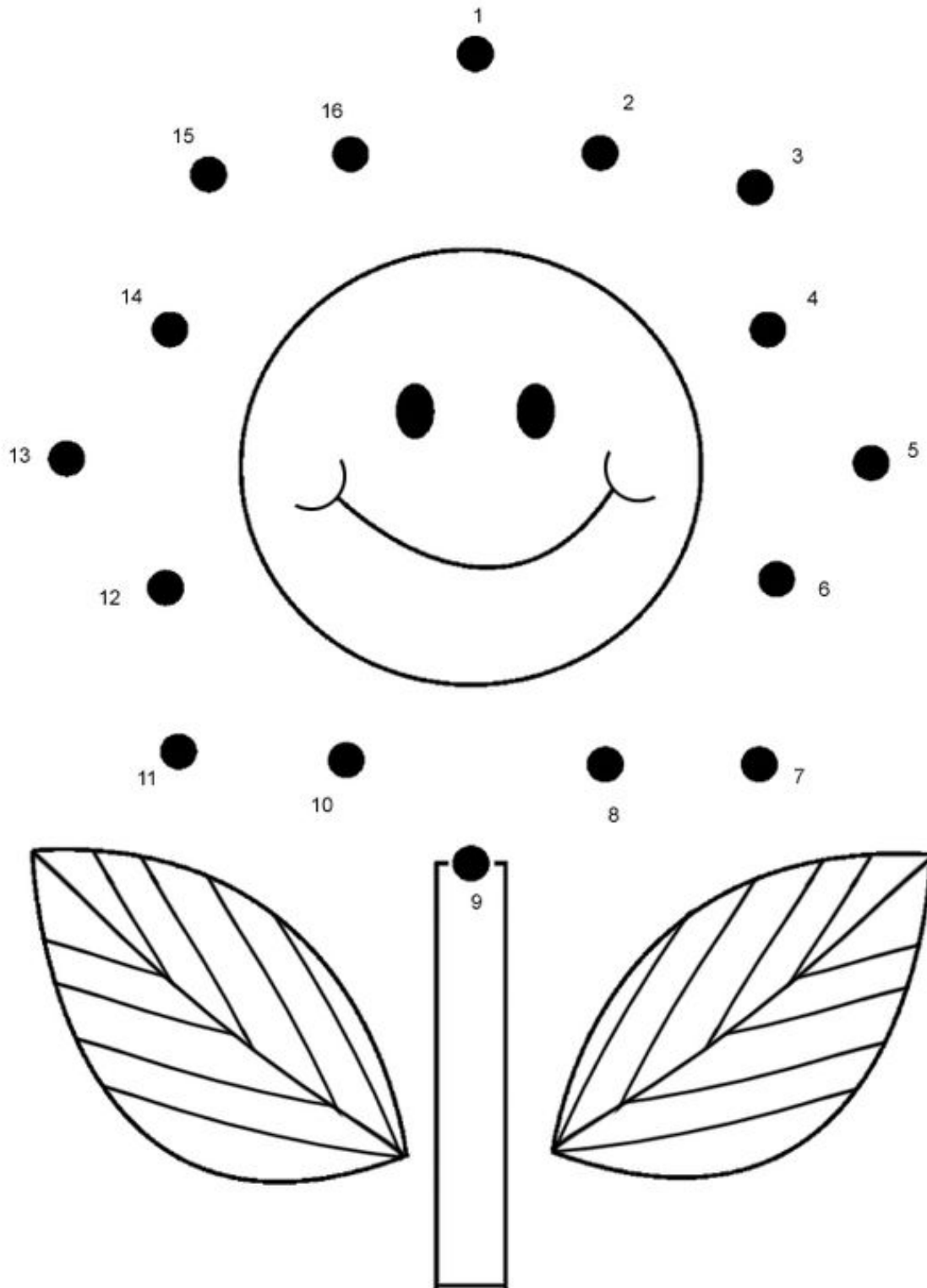

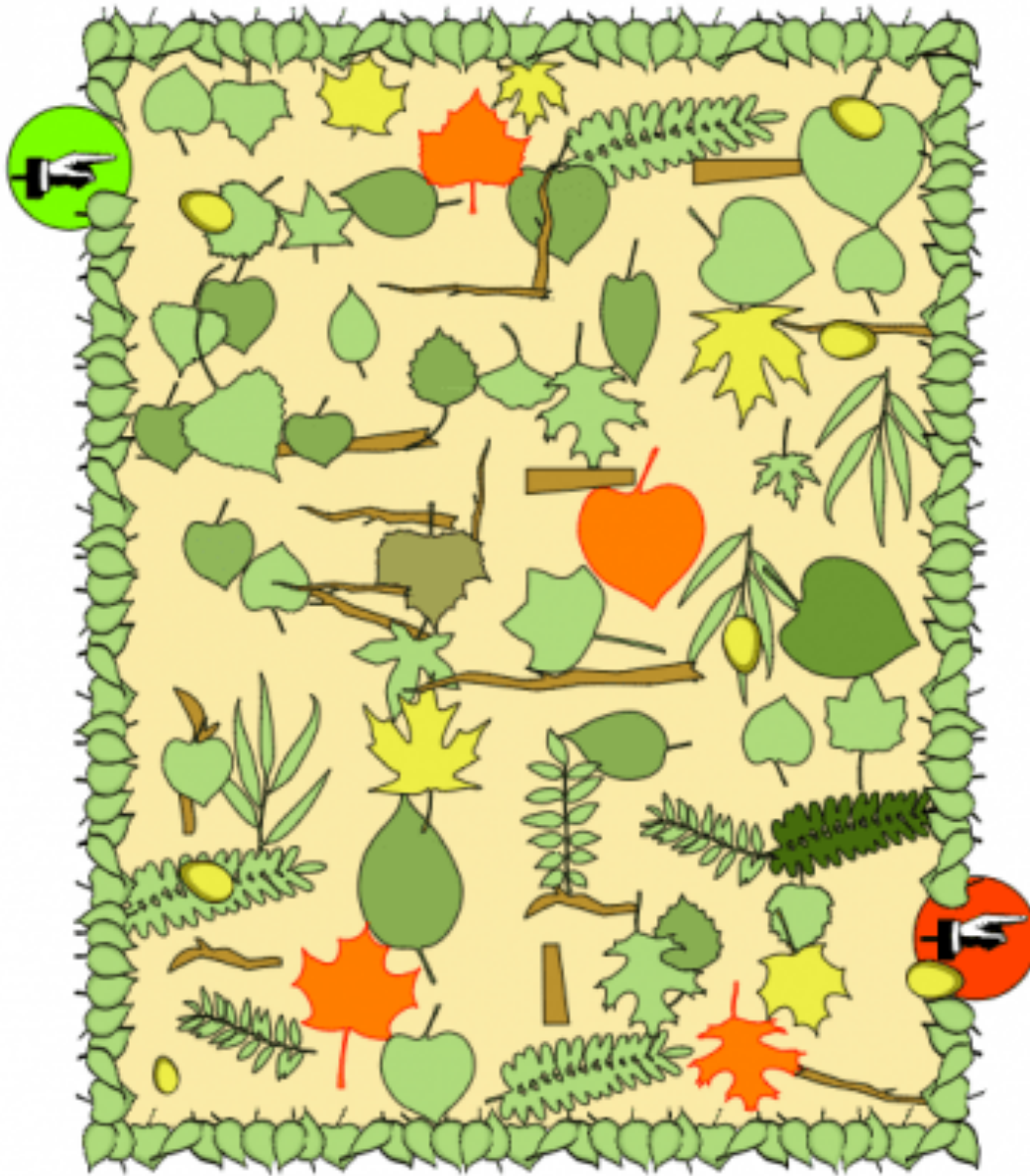

## Teen Talk

**Bible Verse: Then God said, “Let the land produce vegetation: seed-bearing plants and trees on the land that bear fruit with seed in it, according to their various kinds.” And it was so..... And God saw that it was good.**

**Genesis 1:11-12 (NIV)**

The verse for today is focusing on the plants and trees that God made on the third day. The last sentence of the verse above says, “And God saw that it was good.” God was deliberately making a world for mankind that was the best possible world. He intended for us to be happy in this beautiful world in which we live. God possessed abundant creativity as displayed in how he made something out of nothing. There are approximately 390,900 plants on this Earth. Many of which you and I have probably never heard of. Each one is unique in its appearance. Only God could make 390,900 different and unique plants. Can you think of a favorite plant? Maybe it is a beautiful flower, like the rose, a massive tree, like the California redwood, a delicious fruit, like the pineapple or tree-like vegetable, such as the broccoli floret.
