(You'll notice that the alcoholic recipes outnumber the non-alcoholic ones; Anglicans are not particularly noted for their temperance.)

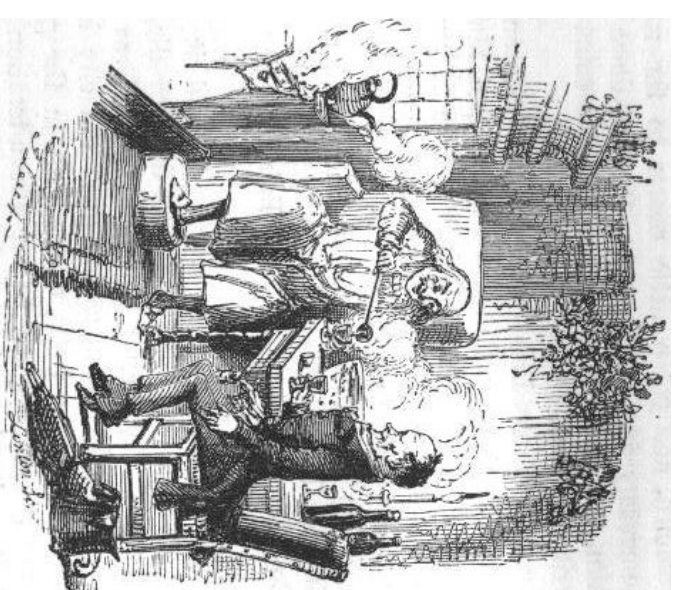
