### ***Flower Show***

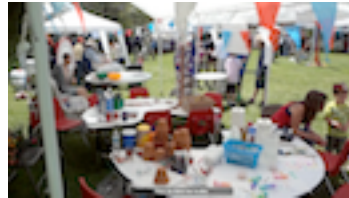
Last year's theme was "Typically British". Stay tuned for news on this year's theme.
